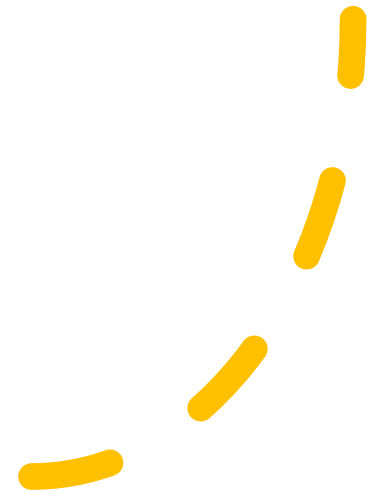

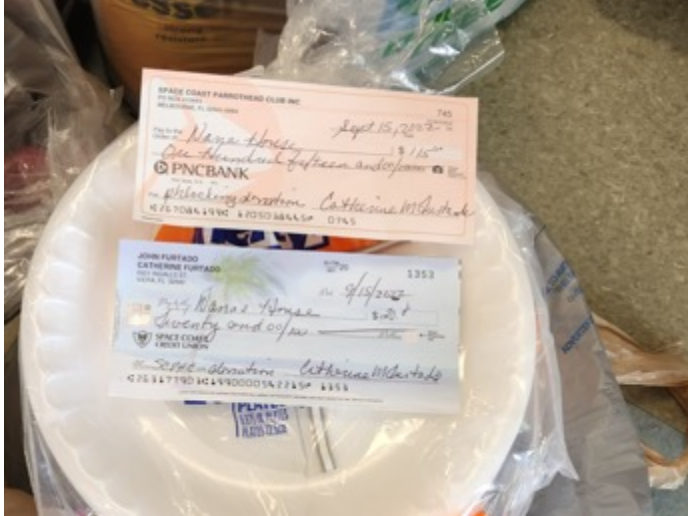


# Where our Donations Go...

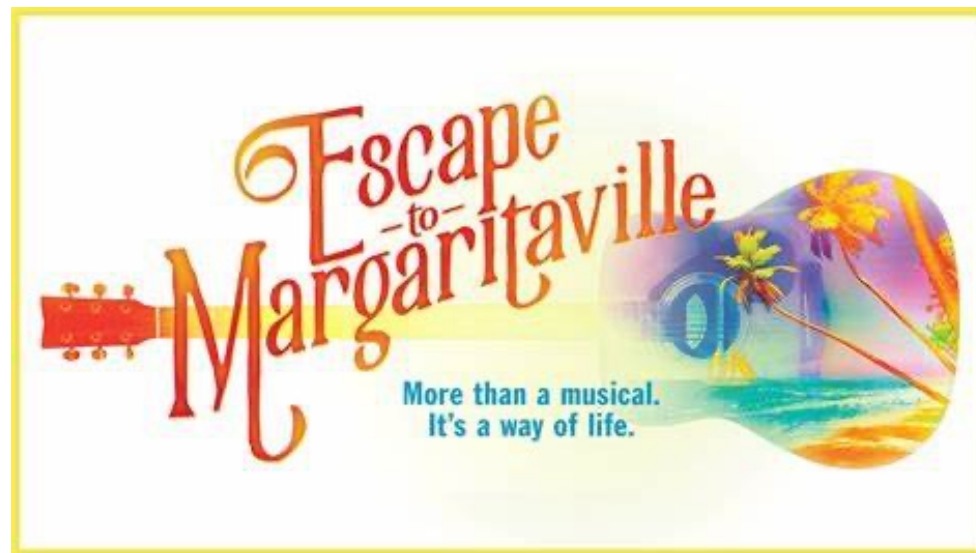

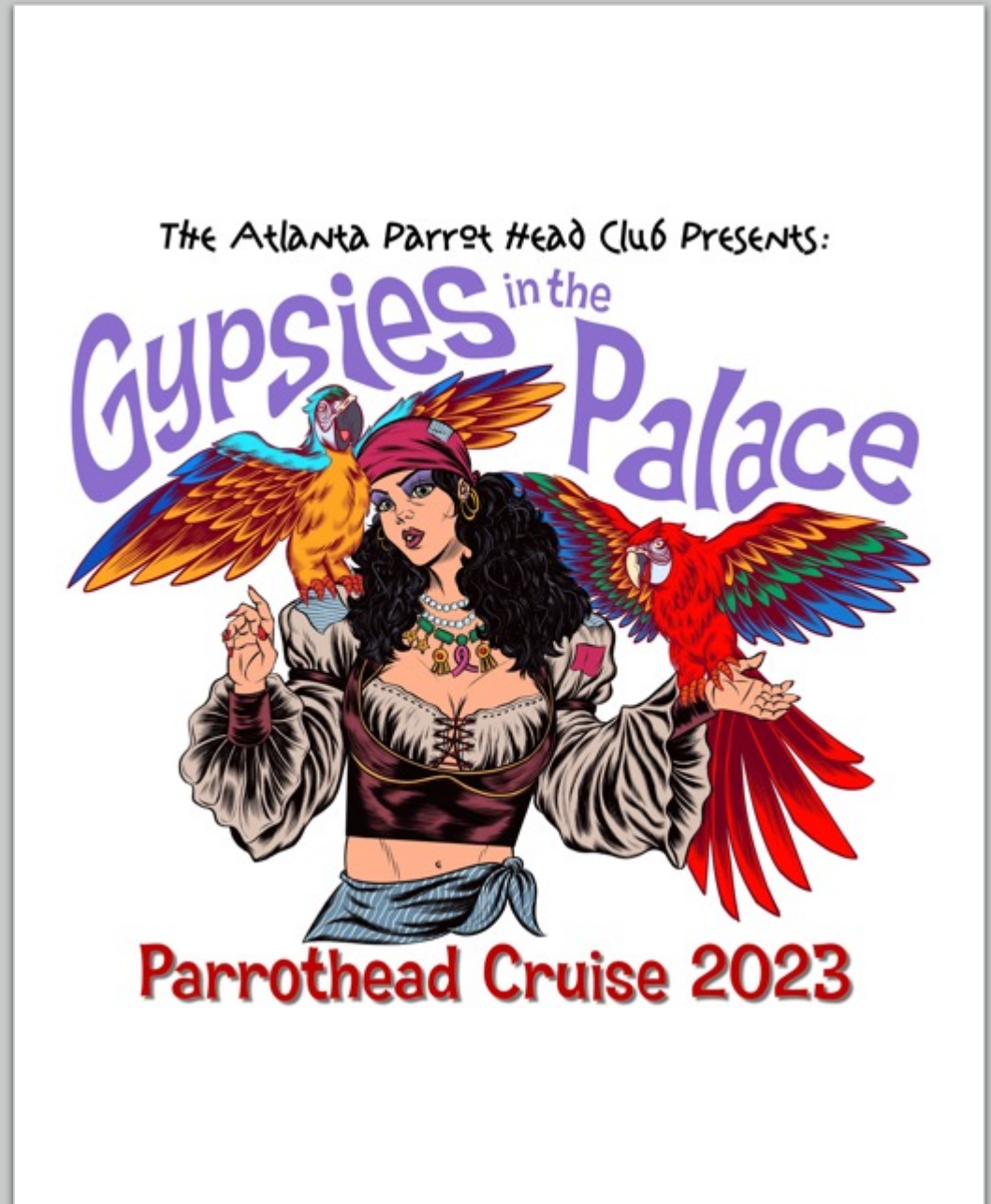

# MISTLETOE MARGARITAS



## Speaking of Partying... Let's Have a Team Drink

### Mistletoe Margaritas

8 Servings

½ C whole cranberries  
¼ C sugar, divided  
2T kosher salt  
1 wedge lime for rim  
2 C cranberry juice  
12 oz silver tequila  
8 oz triple sec  
½ C plus 1T lime juice, divided  
12 C ice

In medium bowl toss cranberries with 1T lime juice  
Drain and then toss with 2T sugar  
Pour onto baking sheet to dry  
Combine remaining sugar with salt on shallow plate  
and combine  
Using the lime wedge wet rim of each glass and dip in  
sugar/salt mixture  
Combine cranberry juice, tequila, triple sec, remaining  
½ C lime juice, and ice in large blender  
Blend until smooth
